

Uzbekistan's Bicameral Parliament
Legislative Chamber (150 Deputies), 135
elected on multipart basis and 15 seats are
given to Ecological Movement of Uzbekistan
Upper House, the Senate (100 Deputies)

The parliament's upper house, the Senate, has 100 deputies elected in equal numbers, i.e. six people from the Karakalpakstan Republic, the country's regions and the Tashkent city. Aside from that, 16 members of the Senate are appointed by the Uzbek president from among the most distinguished citizens.

The legislative chamber permanently has 150 deputies (elections 2009) from four political parties and the Uzbek Ecological Movement. They were elected for a five-year period.
